



Office Apps

- "Yet another application to learn, I don't have time"
- "Why do I need it, again?"
- It is a tool for managers to be on their case – once an opportunity is entered in the CRM system, they can be sure that they'll be pressured "Why haven't you closed that deal yet?"
 - "To keep track of my opportunities better... yeah right?"
 - "They (the management) are using it as control, to monitor my REAL performance"
- Customer data is kept in many different places in companies today, making it hard to get a Customer 360 degree view when needed
- Structured (Line of Business) and unstructured (email, documents) data exist in disconnected islands, locking data into silos, making it hard to find the information, and rendering a common user experience impossible

According to John Goff, "Head Games," CFO Magazine, in July, 2004, Project failure rates for CRM implementations continue to challenge businesses: only 16 percent of CRM projects result in a positive ROI. Key to the failures of leading CRM solution is end user adoption. As William Zarbock President of Castle CRM, a Wall Street based CRM consultancy said, "very (very) few salespeople actually like using CRM systems—which is blasphemy for someone who makes a living providing CRM products and services: If adoption hooks aren't built into the CRM system, your end-users won't use the system."

Document Sets:

- New object to manage work products made up of multiple documents
- Key Scenarios
 - Tight collection of documents
 - A sales proposal that includes documents (proposal), spreadsheets (quotation), and presentations
 - Heterogeneous file types not usually assembled
 - Compound documents
 - A user manual that is an assembled roll-up of separate sections
- Document Set Features
 - Shared Metadata
 - Customized welcome page
 - Default documents added
 - Version capture
 - Workflows
 - Portability (download/upload/send to record center)

- Automate repetitive content creation
- Guide users through complex processes



